



DON'T BIN YOUR USED BATTERIES!



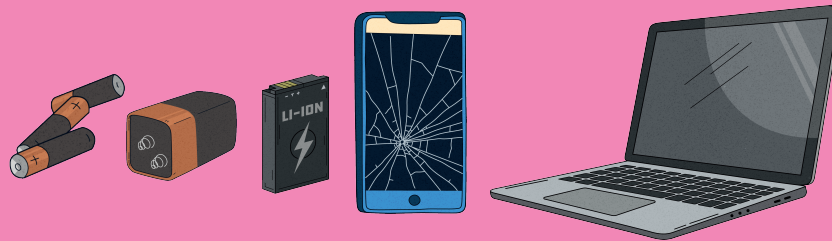
It can cause fires.

Batteries can cause fires and release toxic chemicals when thrown in regular recycling or household rubbish. If they end up in landfill, they can harm the environment by polluting waterways and ecosystems.



What you can do:

- 1 Remove batteries** (including rechargeable ones) from tools, toys, and other devices.



- 2 Tape your terminals**
If battery terminals touch, they can spark and catch fire. To prevent this, tape the terminals of used batteries. Always use clear sticky tape.
- 3 Store them in a jar or container at home.**
- 4 Take your used batteries to a recycling drop-off point like:**
